Brief CV: Crispian Scully qualified in Dentistry at the University of London in 1968 and trained for a Bachelor of Science in Biochemistry (1971: first class honours). He qualified in Medicine (1974) before undertaking research as a Research Fellow funded by the Medical Research Council. His Doctor of Philosophy, in Pathology, was awarded in 1979 and he was appointed Lecturer and then Senior Lecturer in Oral Medicine and Immunology at the University of Glasgow, obtaining the Fellowship in Dental Surgery (Glasgow) in 1979. In 1982 he was appointed to the Chair and Head of Department of Oral Medicine, Surgery and Pathology at the University of Bristol. He was appointed Dean from 1985-1990. He gained his Membership in Pathology (1983), Doctorate in Medicine (1987) and Mastership in Dental Surgery (1988) on the basis of research publications, the Fellowship in Oral Medicine (Ireland) by examination in 1989, the Fellowship in Dental Surgery (England) and Fellowship of the Royal College of Pathologists in 1992 and the Fellowship in Dental Surgery (Edinburgh) in 1998. Professor Scully was appointed Dean, Director of Studies and Research, and Professor of Oral Medicine, Pathology and Microbiology at the Eastman Dental Institute for Oral Healthcare

Sciences, University of London in 1994 and was re-appointed for 2 further 5 year terms from 1999 and 2004. Professor Scully is Co-director of the World Health Organisation Collaborating Centre for oral health, disability and culture. He was Clinical Director of the Eastman 1995-1996. He is a member of the UK Academy of Medical Sciences, an elected member of the General Dental Council, a member of the Medical Research Council Cross Board Committee, a member of the Expert Advisory Group on AIDS (EAGA) working party on Lookback Studies (Department of Health, DoH), a member of the National Centre for Clinical Excellence (NICE) working group on Oral Cancer, and a member of Court of Middlesex University. Previously he was honorary consultant at the Bristol Royal Infirmary and Dental Hospital, the Royal London Hospital, the Nuffield Orthopaedic Centre Oxford, the Horizon Trust St Albans and the Royal Free Hospital, London. He was a member of the working group on Oral Health of the Surgeon-General of the USA, and a member of the Steering Group of the European College of Dentistry. Professor Scully has been Consultant Advisor in Dental Research to the UK Chief Medical Officer, and has been a member of Medical Research Council Grants Committees, the NHS Central Research and Development Committee, a member of the Expert Advisory Group on Antimicrobial Resistance (DoH), a member of the Advisory Committee on HIV-infected Health Care Workers (DoH), a member of the Higher Education Funding Council (HEFCE) Dental Research Review Panel, Chairman of the Central Examining Board for Hygienists, and President and a Council member of the British Society for Oral Medicine. He was Chairman of the Joint Advisory Committee for Additional Dental Specialties, member of the UK Standing Dental Advisory Committee, and Chairman of the Chemoprevention Group of the European Organisation for Research and Treatment of Cancer. He has been on the Medicines Control Agency, the Advisory Council on the Misuse of Drugs, Medical Research Council Grants Committees, and the Joint Dental Research Committee of the Medical Research Council, the Science and Engineering Research Council and the DoH, and was on the Specialisation Task Force of the General Dental Council.

Professor Scully has lectured worldwide mainly on oral medicine, oral pathology and special care dentistry. He has received the University of

Helsinki Medal of Honour, and written 30 books, and numerous chapters, research papers, and reviews on clinical problems. He has over 640 papers cited on MEDLINE. Recent books have included *Oral and Maxillofacial Medicine*; *Orofacial Disease*; *Update for the Dental Clinical Team*; *Oxford Handbook of Applied Dental Sciences* ;*Oxford Handbook of Dental Patient Care*; and *Periodontal Manifestations of Local and Systemic Disease*. His book *Medical Problems in Dentistry* was awarded a Prize for one of the top-selling medical or dental books worldwide. He is involved in several journals, including as Editor of *Oral Oncology*, co-Editor of *Oral Diseases* and on the editorial boards of journals such as the *International Journal of Oncology*, *Archives of Oral Biology* *Continuing Professional Development in Dentistry* and *Oral Biosciences and Medicine*.
